

## Multicultural Histories and Legacies of Rome: Classics, Colosseums and Cathedrals

#### About the Experience

The Multicultural Histories and Legacies of Rome: Classics, Colosseums and Cathedrals is a two-part experience features an eight-day global learning experience in Rome, Italy (with excursions to Florence and near Pompeii) that creates a hands-on way to explore the ideas, concepts, and theories examined in a semester-long course taught at the Ohio State University Columbus campus.

The ES HESA 3573-MUNDO Multicultural Histories and Legacies course will examine the concept of social change in domestic and global contexts through digital media, lectures, interactive discussions, and hands-on experiences facilitated by the course instructors/resident directors as well as local and international community members, civic leaders, and scholars.

The spring break study abroad component of the course occurs March 11-18, 2022. The opportunity focuses on ways to understand what social change is and how (and when) to implement it to create more just, inclusive, and equitable communities at home and abroad. #### About the Study Abroad Grant

A total of \$5000 has been allocated for grants of \$100-\$750 in value to be awarded to applications that both meet the grant award criteria and submission deadlines indicated below.

#### MUNDO Study Abroad Travel Grant Award Criteria, Deadlines and Notification:

Criteria used in determining the selection of recipients will include:

- status as full-time OSU student
- residence in a University Housing Residence Hall or property
- academic/personal qualifications described in essay responses
- expressed financial need or other special circumstances

**NOTES:** Preference will be given to students who live in University Residences, who are active in MUNDO (Multicultural Understanding through Nontraditional Discovery Opportunities) or other Residence Life Involved Living Organization, STEP (The Second-Year Transformational Program) and/or the Program for Advancing in Scholarship and Service (PASS), but all students are strongly encouraged to apply.
